Primary responsibilities will include:

- The Loftsman in the Engineering Operations Department is responsible for the development of structural components in a 3D environment for NC cutting of parts, as well as the development of assembly drawings, and nest plate drawings for production.
- The Loftsman should be familiar with basic ship design principles and nomenclature, production methods and fabrication techniques in a Shipyard or Marine Facility. Knowledge of Marine codes, standards and regulations is also a plus.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum 5 years of lofting and/or structural design experience in the marine industry
- Proficient in computer aided drafting. AutoCAD 3D experience. ShipConstructor experience preferred.

Basic Requirements:

- Familiarity with regulatory and classification requirements
- Familiarity with manufacturing and production methods
- Familiarity with vessel construction.

Physical Requirements:

- Limited physical activity in an office environment
- Physical ability to participate in shipyard and shipboard surveys involving access to confined spaces, climbing vertical ladders and scaffolding, minor lifting, and other activity
